





Vice-Chairman resignation

David Holliday, the Vice-Chairman of the Parish Council has stood down after some 20 years service including a spell as Chairman of the Parish Council. We are most grateful to David for his commitment and contribution to the Council and to the community.

Budget 2018/19

Following a review Council determined to increase the precept for 2018/19 to ensure that adequate funds were available to meet unforeseen contingencies (notably to cover fees for professional services) and to cover the costs of compliance with new data protection regulations.

Community Fund

Rix Petroleum have made a first contribution of £145.74 to the Wilby Community Fund reflecting payments made by its customers in the village.

Annual Parish Meeting

The Annual Parish Meeting open to everyone in Wilby will be held in the Coronation Hall at 7 pm on Wednesday 9 May 2018. Details of the agenda will be published nearer to the date and refreshments will be available at the conclusion of the meeting.

The next meeting of the Council will be its Annual Meeting, at which it is formally reconstituted with the Chairman and Vice-Chairman being elected, will be held in the Coronation Hall at **7.30 pm on Wednesday 2 May 2018.**

An explanation of what the 'Precept' actually is!!

The Precept is a way of raising money for our Parish Council through receiving a percentage of 'Council Tax' from Mid Suffolk. Each Parish has to submit a request to the District Council in January for funding as to expected expenditure for the year to come.

This year 2018/19 a request for £3500.00 has been made this is broken down briefly as follows:

Repayment of a 25 year loan for rebuilding of the Village Hall of £895.00 per annum has only a few more years left to run.

Clerk's salary and expenses approx. £1250, Insurance £350, subscriptions to various local bodies £350.00, Audit fees £200.

There are other assorted expenses such as Mandatory inspections, Street lighting at Crown Corner, PC. Meeting expenses, Councillor training and MSDC costs for Dog bin cleansing, plus Website funding make up most of the balance. The Parish Council is required to maintain a balance in excess of needs in expectation of possible extra costs, therefore any balance (very small) is banked.

In about June each year the Account have to be formally audited and are available for inspection by the Community upon request to the Clerk (Details on Brundish PC Website).

The Village Green and Defibrillator are maintained from separate funding and do not form part of the Precept

Framlingham Medical Practice News

Dr Carley & Dr Brooks

We are delighted to welcome back Dr Carley from her maternity leave and we are grateful to Dr Brooks for covering for her over the past year and are pleased he will be returning from time to time to do some more locum cover.

Dr Hopton Cycle India

In November Dr Hopton is embarking on a 500 km cycle from Agra to Jaipur in 5 days. She is raising money for women v cancer (breast, cervical and ovarian cancers). The Hearing Care Centre has given the surgery a large tower of chocolates, sweets and biscuits and we will shortly be raffling this off in aid of the charity.

Proposed Extension to Surgery

Having had confirmation of the Community Infrastructure Levy we are tentatively moving forward with plans to extend the surgery. Over the next few weeks builders will be at the surgery preparing quotes for the work and once completed these will be re-submitted to NHS England for further consideration and, hopefully, final confirmation of a grant.

Missed Appointments

It would be very helpful if patients could inform reception if they are unable to attend an appointment. In the last quarter (1st October – 31st December 2017) there were 284 missed appointments which equates to over 47 hours of wasted clinical time.

Travelling abroad with Medication

We all have heard in the news of people being imprisoned for carrying illegal medication into a country and we have the following advice for our patients travelling with medication:

It is the patient's responsibility to establish the rules for their destination, airline and any country they are travelling through. These may all be different!

You need to remember prescribed AND over-the-counter medications. *(In some areas, common over-the-counter medications such as nasal decongestant inhalers (VICKS to you and I) and cough linctus are banned.)*

Even travelling within Europe may require some care if you are using controlled drugs:

Government advice is that a patient must be able to prove controlled medication belongs to them to travel into or out of the UK.

This requires a letter outlining use and countersigned by 'the person who prescribed the drugs'.

If carrying more than 3 months' supply, they will also need a Home Office licence: <https://www.gov.uk/travelling-controlled-drugs>

We advise you to contact the Embassy to ensure your medication is permitted.



The project which is being run in conjunction with York and Durham Universities is a chance for us to further develop the work we have begun on Growth Mindset and provides us with an opportunity to help our children to achieve their fullest potential in all areas.

Julia led workshops with all age groups, from Pre-School to Y6, who enthusiastically entered into the spirit of the day by dressing up as their favourite book characters.




