Dear Friends,

**Happy New Year!**

Our first festival this year – as always, is Epiphany. Have you ever wondered why we take our Christmas decorations down on Epiphany, January 6<sup>th</sup>? Simply, it was considered unlucky to leave them up after twelfth night, which makes it even more confusing because twelfth night is actually January 5<sup>th</sup>, though some would argue it is January 4<sup>th</sup>! Is it important? No, it isn't – it's entirely up to you when you take the decorations down; I once knew someone who left them up until March, but they were looking a little sad by then.

January 6<sup>th</sup> not only is Epiphany, but it is the start of Epiphanytide which brings together the Magi, the Baptism of Christ, and the Miracle of Cana (changing water into wine). These are three very profound signs that encourages us to reflect upon the consequences of Christ's coming among us and provides an opportunity to reflect on what this means in terms of his ministry and consequently, ours.

To me the most startling thing about the Magi, is that they were not Jews, but Gentiles. Similarly, the first to hear the Good News about the birth of the Messiah were not politicians, or Kings, or wealthy people but shepherds, ordinary working class people. These were very important signs that Christ is the saviour of all, not just the Jews but Gentiles too and that the Christian message is for all classes. This was very difficult for some to grasp, just look at the fierce debate that took place among the apostles after Christ's ascension. Christ's mission, and therefore ours is to the whole world and all people, wherever we find them and whoever they are.

I pray that you all have a happy and fulfilling new year.

## PARISH COUNCIL NEWS - January 2015

### Warning after bogus 'police officer' scams pensioner

Police are again urging people to be vigilant after a pensioner was conned out of thousands of pounds while another had a 'lucky escape' by men posing a police officers. On Monday 20 October, an 81-year-old woman from the Bury St Edmunds area was contacted by phone by a man claiming that he was a police officer. He said that someone had tried to access her bank account and she would therefore need to withdraw the cash so that it could be checked. The bogus police officer made several phone calls, instructing the victim not to tell anyone about his requests because he was working undercover and saying he would book a taxi for her so that she could bring him the money. The woman refused and told a friend after which police were contacted. No money was handed over.

On Thursday 23 October, a 77-year-old woman from Shotley also received a telephone call from a man purporting to be a police officer. He claimed that bank staff were trying to steal all her money from her account and, in order to protect it, she should withdraw it all and hand it over to him. Again, she was told not to tell anyone and a taxi was booked for her. She got the taxi to her bank where she withdrew money, before travelling to London where she handed over £4,000 to a man.

Detectives investigating both crimes are reminding people not to divulge bank account details, PINs or withdraw any cash for the police. DI David Giles said:  
*"If you have vulnerable or elderly family, friends, or neighbours, please take the time to make sure they are aware never to give out personal information over the phone to people they don't know – especially bank details."*

The police or your bank will never ask for this information on the phone so if you do get a call like this please hang up immediately and leave five minutes before reporting it to the police, as the fraudsters may stay on the line. *"We will also never ask to take money from people so please don't hand over cash to anyone claiming to be working for the police."*

Suffolk police officers have spoken to both women and are currently carrying out investigations. If you believe that you or someone you know may have been affected by a scam such as this, or similar, please call the police on 101 or 999 if it is an emergency.

## NEWS FROM WILBY SCHOOL

### Happy New Year from Wilby School!

We're delighted to announce that, based upon the SATs tests taken by last year's Year 6 children, Wilby Primary School has the 12th highest attainment out of all primary schools in England – according to the BBC Primary School League Table. 100% of our children achieved a Level 4 or above in each of reading, writing and maths (against 74% for Suffolk and 79% across all schools in England). In fact - 100% achieved a Level 5 or above in reading, and 91% reached Level 5 in maths. Every child in this class achieved two levels of progress since the end of Key Stage 1 in each of reading, writing and maths. We're so proud of our children, and of course our staff and parents!

Many thanks to all who supported the school Christmas Fayre. Of course it's mainly about having a good time, but the event is also one of the Friends of the School's principal fundraisers – and this time over £1,100 was raised.

In December our choir and brass players entertained the residents of Foxearth Lodge Nursing Home, and also played at the Co-op in Framlingham, collecting £74 for the East Anglian Children's Hospice. In addition we performed at the Pyramid carol service at Worlingworth Church, had a wonderful Christmas performance by our 'Chestnut' class, a celebration of Christmas music in the school hall, and our Christmas service at St Mary's Church.

As a reminder, the school's toddler playgroup ('Tea & Toys') is now a weekly event – Thursdays from 9 til 10:30am. Any parents and children (up to age 5) from the local area are welcome. We are sure this will complement other playgroups nearby.  
*Come for a cuppa and meet other mums & dads!*

Through the week we offer a variety of after school clubs – which are both great fun for the children but also give parents an extra hour for work or other commitments. Activities this term are: drama, craft, textiles, dance, science, yoga and dodgeball.
